HAPPY SCHOOL PROJECT

Strengthening of School Management Committee

Team of the project participated in 10 School Management Committee meetings and oriented the importance of the SMC meeting. They also welcomed new admission and distributed stationery to the children at PUMS Udayampalayam , PUMS Somayanoor, and PUMS 24 Veerapandi.

**Formation / Strengthening of Child Parliament**

Children parliament was formed in 10 schools during 2nd and 3rd phases of the project. A training was organized which equipped children with the basic concept of the Children Parliament. It provided an opportunity to learn life skills for example, about their rights, health, and education etc. As a result, they become aware and contributed to the decision-making process of the administrative system.

LIVELIHOOD PROJECT FOR MARGINALIZED WOMEN

110 kids were donated by beneficiaries to the neediest women in their village. Earlier, a year back, 250 Goats were donated to 50 widows from marginalized communities. These goats gave birth and then the kids were being donated to other needy women by the beneficiaries. This was a heartfelt moment for NMCT as well as BOSCH as we now know that the donations have gone to people with noble heart.

TI-MIGRANTS PROJECT, COIMBATORE

The team organized HIV/STI and TB Awareness Program on 24.06.2022 at Majestic Exports Spinning Private Limited, Kanjapalli, Annur with the participation of more than 200 Industrial Migrant workers.



An Exhibition stall was placed at Vasanthi Foundry, Thennampalayam, Sulur on 25.06.2022. 100 At-Risk Migrants have visited the stall and got to know the awareness on HIV/AIDS.



The Team organized Stakeholder Meeting at Annur Bus Stand and Thondamuthur Bus Stand on 22.06.2022 and 23.06.2022 respectively. The meeting addressed topics such as Migrants flow, Lifestyle, Habit and Habitat, Residence and Risk management.

LIFE PROJECT

In order to scale up leadership skills, self-determination, self-awareness, and self-confidence and to create awareness about the career choices, training was conducted for CLHIV/CAA on 11.06.2022 at Lions Club Hall, Tirupur with 52 participants. The training was conducted by Mr. S.Balamurugan from Cactus Social Educational Health and Research Foundation. Possibilities after 10th and 12th, notable Universities and Entrance Exams were explained in detail to the children. The session created awareness about the choices/opportunities available to them.

Integrated Tribal Development Project-NABARD

The project had Monitoring visit by Ms.Rajalexmi, NABARD Consultant on 28.06.2022 and visited the established farming lands and newly identified farming lands in Arakadavu and Gethaikadu tribal villages respectively. She also verified the growth of the Livestock animals in Thondai tribal village.





Organized monthly VPC Meeting at Athikadavu on 30.06.2022 and discussed the progress of Wadi Activities in the target area. All the VPC members were provided with blankets as an appreciation of their work.



Project Director of the project participated in Half Yearly Review meeting in Nabard Regional office, Chennai on 15.06.2022 and presented the interventions of NMCT in the Tribal area.



Farmers were motivated to establish farm ponds in their farming lands to preserve and conserve the water for irrigation. 19 farmers have completed establishing the farm ponds in the target area.

WaSh PROJECT

2 MHM Campaigns were organized at GHS Kanuvai and PUMS Vattamalaipalayam with the participation of 204 students. Topics such as Menstrual Hygiene, Nutritious food and menstrual cycle were explained in the program through activities along with instructions on using a menstrual calendar. Solutions to the problems face during the menstrual were also given.





2 Teacher Trainings were conducted at PUMS Chinnamettupalayam and GHS Kanuvai respectively with the participation of 32 teachers. The topics included Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WaSH) and Menstrual Hygiene Management (MHM).



4 WaSH trainings were conducted with the participation of 111 members. Importance of hand wash and steps of washing hands were explained through activities. Soap, sanitizer and masks were also distributed to the children after the training.



3 SMC trainings were conducted in PUMS Gopnari, PUPS Athikadavu and PUMS ChinnaThottipalayam with the participation of 60 SMC members and discussed about school development

Students of Abhaya Students Shelter have participated in Swachh Bharath Competition on the theme of “No Plastic” organized by District Child Protection Unit (DCPU) and participated in the competitions in the form of Poster making, Slogan writing and Elocution.
